Reminders from the Clinic / Attendance Office

Parents must call the attendance hotline ([239-274-6746](tel:239-274-6746)) by 9:30 a.m. the day of an absence. Students are required to present a written note to the School Nurse stating the reason for the absence on the day they return to school. If a note is not turned in

the day the student returns, a detention will be given each day until a note is received. If a doctor has seen the student, medical documentation should accompany the parent note. If it is necessary for a student to leave school for an appointment, a note signed by a parent or guardian must be presented to the School Nurse prior to the start of the school day. The note must give an explanation of the circumstances and the time of the departure. Parents are discouraged from arriving on campus without earlier notification to pick up their child for unexpected appointments.
