- All service needs to be completed at a non-profit agency.
 - All projects must be on the “Volunteer Options” list below or pre-approved by Campus Ministry PRIOR to engaging in service, otherwise please recognize that service completed without pre-approval may be deemed invalid.
 - Students may volunteer at a BVHS summer sports camp for a maximum of half of your service hour requirement (I.E. Juniors/Seniors may earn up to 15; Freshmen/Sophomores may earn up to 10)
- Hours will only be accepted if service is performed and documented over the summer or within the current school year.
- Hours that exceed the minimum requirement will not apply to the next school year. However, students may turn in more than the required amount if they would like them recorded.
- To proceed to the next grade level, freshmen and sophomores must complete and document 20 hours EACH academic year and submit documentation on or before Wednesday, May 6, 2020. There may be immediate disciplinary consequences and/or restriction of privileges for failure to submit on time.
- To proceed to the next grade level or graduate, juniors and seniors must complete and document 30 hours EACH academic year and submit documentation on or before Wednesday, March 4, 2020. There may be immediate disciplinary consequences and/or restriction of privileges for failure to submit on time.
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- Submitting will work one of two ways:
 - 1) A student submits the form with all five lines complete at any time or the student submits the form with less than five lines complete one week prior to the end of the quarter or by the school year deadline. Hours are recorded on report cards at the end of each quarter.
 - 2) A student completes ALL of their hours over the summer and submits this paper once.
 - Hours performed over the summer must be turned in on or before August 30, 2019 to receive any credit. Any hours turned in after this date will NOT be counted. □
- It is the student's responsibility to provide this form to the agency at the time of the project, in order to verify participation.
 - Submit either the supervisor's business card or a signed letter with the agency's letter head if this form is not available at the time of service. Please attach it to this form and indicate the attachment by filling out one of the rows above.
- All of the information on this form must be filled out completely and accurately. No signature will be accepted of a parent, friend or anyone under the age of 18 in lieu of a site supervisor. Any forged or misinformation will be treated as academic dishonesty (See Student Handbook). All forms must be submitted electronically via Canvas
