- 4) That's it!

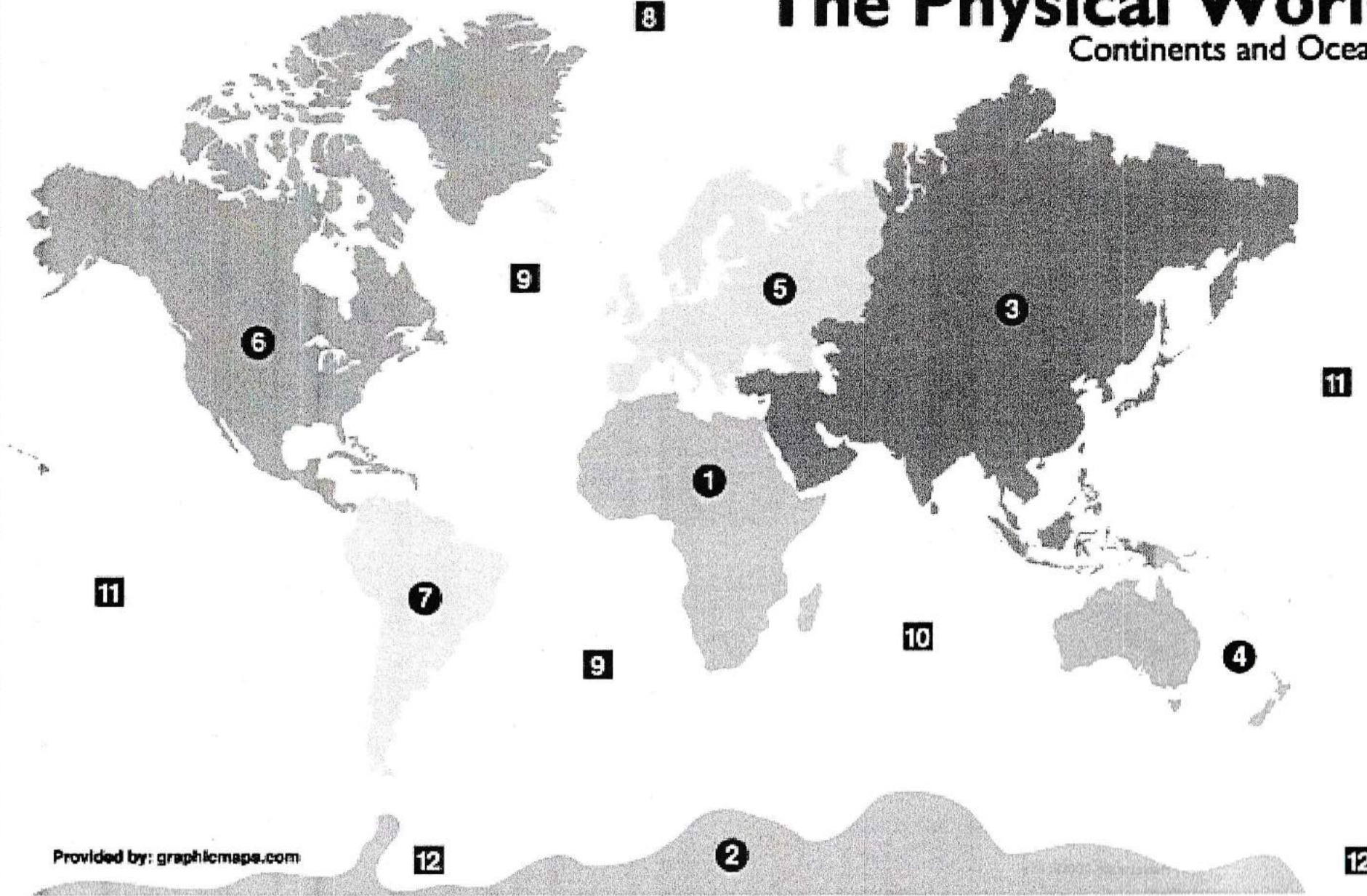
