To help with your child's success, the School Counseling Department uses Naviance, a state of the art technology program, to help with the career and college process. Students will take personality and interest assessments, research careers and colleges and, once they are a senior, track their college applications and

make requests for letters of recommendation and transcripts to be sent. Freshmen Parents: We have now completed the Quarter 1 Student Services classroom presentations with all freshman.
